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The Ship Inn first appeared in the history of Freckleton in about 1630 and stands in an elevated position overlooking a creek of the River Ribble. Records show that The Ship Inn was in existence in 1677 when it was first licensed, however it is thought the pub dates back to the 14th Century, making it the oldest pub in the Fylde. It was known as Bunkers Hill from the late 18th to mid 19th century, after the 1775 battle between British and America colonists, but in 1824 was also referred to as The Ship Inn. Smuggling, fighting, fraternising, ghostly tales, carousing; The Ship Inn has seen it all - and who knows what the future may hold.

Today The Ship Inn still makes a strong positive contribution to the townscape of Freckleton, bringing in both locals and those from further afield. It is the perfect destination venue serving fresh homemade food, real ales, cocktails, wine and artisan soft drinks. In 1847 the former bowling green to the east of the building now offers ample parking for families and their four legged friends. Our large beer garden with stunning views across Freckleton Marsh, along with our position near BAE Warton, provide a great spot for bird and aircraft lovers alike. If exploring is more your thing, The Ship Inn is an early stop on The Coastal Walk from Freckleton through to Lytham and St Annes.
